*These exam times indicate the actual length of time for the exam. Students will actually enter and begin approximately 15 minutes prior to the scheduled time (see arrival time). This additional time is needed to pass out the exams and provide examinees with an opportunity to read the exam questions before the exam officially begins. Also, please note that examinees will not be dismissed at the exact time that an exam concludes. All exam papers must first be collected and counted. Consequently, examinees will be dismissed 5-10 minutes after the conclusion of each exam.

****Students who are testing in AP exams and alternative exams have a grey highlighted field. Please double check attendance.**

PLEASE NOTE:

- ⇒ **Both testing areas will be used constantly, so teachers are advised to find a secure area for testing students' belongings. (a locker would be suitable)**
- Students **are expected to attend** all classes during the exam period.
- It is critical that students report to the appropriate locations **on time**. Students must complete IB or AP exams to receive weighted grades. **(teachers should arrange for coverage of other classes so they can take roll of examinees before the proctor arrives)**
- All Stonewall teachers will receive rosters of students sitting for IB/AP exams. Please read these over carefully.
- Students will remain on campus during the school day.
- While instruction will not stop during the exam period, teachers will limit out of class assigned work. Students are encouraged to take advantage of any help or review sessions offered during the exam period.
- Students need to bring **black ink pens and #2 pencils to exams.**
- **For IB Math and Science exams**, students should bring the **appropriate calculator** along with extra batteries (a backup calculator is suggested). Students should be prepared for an onsite verification of the appropriate calculator and appropriate calculator programs; students must comply with the IB calculator regulations or be rejected from the exam site.
- Students will also be rejected from the exam site for failure to appropriately submit **IB Internal Assessment**.
- This schedule is subject to change. Any necessary changes will be announced in the appropriate classes. If you have any questions on the exam process, please ask your teacher or Mrs. Ellis.
